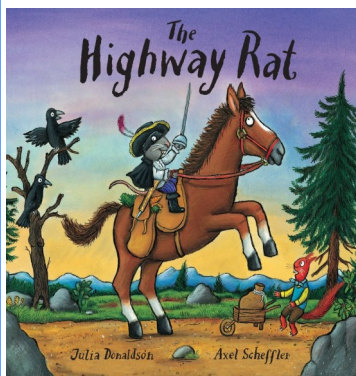


Absence and Lateness

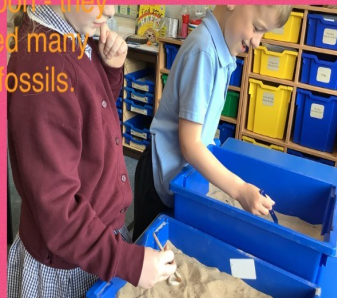
